What is Respite Care?

Caregivers may need some time for themselves and must depend on others to help in caring for their dependent loved one. Mercy Medical's assisted living and memory care communities offer a respite program that allows for a period of rest and relief for caregivers.

What services and provisions are included in Respite?

Respite at the John McClure Snook Regional Center, a leading memory care community specializing in Alzheimer's and dementia care, includes:

- A furnished, private room and bathroom
- Three meals a day
- Assistance with personal care needs
- Housekeeping/laundry services
- Stimulating morning & afternoon memory-focused activities
- Assistance with medications
- All linen needs during the length of stay

What are the admission criteria for Respite?

The Snook Center Respite Program requires:

- A three-day minimum stay
- Up to a 30-day maximum stay
- A plan of care
- Admission assessment
- Admission and discharge recommended Monday thru Friday

What are the Respite fees?

Respite at the John McClure Snook Regional Center fees include:

- A \$200 one-time deposit is required prior to the respite stay
- A daily rate of \$165
